NEW - Ball Machine

In response to requests from Club Members the Board of Directors has approved a proposal to purchase a ball machine.

Over the winter a small group of members (Gerry Kowalchuk, Julian Ward, Marilyn Francis & Ross Robinson) put together a program that was subsequently approved by the Board of Directors.

For a one time fee of \$50 per person Club Members can get unlimited access to the ball machine. White Oaks rents their ball machine for \$20 an hour so a flat fee of \$50 is



hopefully viewed as a good deal for members and provides a method for the Club to recover the costs involved with the acquisition, with minimal additional administration.

TENNIS ETIQUITTE - DID YOU KNOW?

It is customary to hit a few warm up balls with your opponent before starting a game.

This is **NOT** the time to hit "winners" or fast paced competitive balls. It is courteous to attempt to place your shots to your opponent so they can be easily returned.

NEW - Divider Screen

The Club has purchased a Divider Net that will be installed by the Town over the next few weeks between Court 3 & 4.

This net is intended to be used during practice sessions (hitting wall practice, ball machine use, lessons) and will be tied back during group play.

We ask all members to help ensure that the screen is property tied back after use so it is not damaged in the wind.

If you see this has not been done when you arrive at the courts, please take a moment to tie back the netting, even if you are not using that particular court.
