We are delighted to announce that yesterday the Town Council gave final approval for their contribution to the following Memorial Park Tennis Club enhancements, which include:

^{**} The four original courts will be re-surfaced to match the two new courts. The new court colours of blue on green will be extended to all six courts.

^{**} The two new courts will have night lighting installed.

** Parking facilities will be improved.
These upgrades will be started later this Fall and completed by Spring 2022 in time for the Games in August.
Part of the Canada Games mandate is to leave legacy improvements for the venues involved with the Games. The Club is honoured to be hosting such a prestigious event and to be the recipient of such significant legacy benefits.
